Sample Daily Agenda

- 8:45 – 9:00 Camper Drop-Off**
- Parents will drop campers off in front of Sands Montessori and will be greeted by staff at the door.
- 9:00 – 9:30 Morning Reflections & Sharing**
- Give campers an opportunity to share about their day yesterday, or their feelings, encourage active listening, focus on Social Emotional learning, review the agenda and set expectations for the day.
- 9:30 – 10:00 Story Time/Independent Reading/Journaling**
- Younger campers will listen to a story read aloud relating to the theme that week. Older campers can choose a themed book for independent reading or practice journaling.
- 10:00 – 11:30 STEAM Projects & Arts and Crafts**
- These projects may include: tower building, egg drops, building with Legos and blocks, science experiments, diorama building, guided online research & presentations, theme related art projects, theme related crafts to take home, etc.
- 11:30 – 12:00 Lunch in Cafeteria**
- Parents should pack a nutritionally balanced lunch for their child daily.
- 12:00 – 12:30 Free Play on Playground**
- Children are encouraged to learn to play well with others and have time to relax and build friendships during unstructured free play.
- 12:30 – 1:30 Outdoor Games, Sports, Theatre, Skits, Song, Dance**
- Four square, freeze tag, capture the flag, musical chairs, soccer, basketball, flag football, dodgeball, jump rope, scooters, hula hoops, Skits, Put on a play, choreograph a song, learn to sing a song, etc.
- 1:30 – 3:30 Swimming/Fun with Water**
- Slip 'n slide, water balloon toss, play in the sprinkler, fun with water blasters (water guns), and swimming at the Mt. Washington Community Recreation Center (CRC) – lifeguards always on duty.
- 3:30 – 3:45 Camper Pick-Up**
- Parents should drive to the west side car pick-up circle for afternoon dismissal.
